## **STANDARDS OF CONDUCT FOR CALVARY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL**

Calvary Christian School holds that the Bible is the infallible, divine Word of God and that salvation by faith in Christ is the initial step in the Christian life. There is adequate Biblical basis for the idea of spiritual growth into the image of Christ (Roman 8:29), which is the work of the Holy Spirit (II Cor. 3:18). This growth begins with the initial act of saving faith and continues throughout life. The Holy Spirit makes the Christian conscious of the Biblical demands for a holy life which fulfills both God's moral law and high law of love (Matthew 22: 37-39, Rom. 13:8-10, Gal. 5:15). The result is a life consecrated unto God and separated from the world.

Calvary Christian School must, therefore, provide an environment conducive to the spiritual growth and development of young people who are not yet mature Christians. A standard of conduct based on the following Biblical imperatives is necessary to provide such an environment. All of the activities of the Christian must be subordinated to the glory of God who indwells us (I Corinthians 8:9, 12, 13, 10:32). The Christian will endeavor to avoid practices which cause the loss of sensitivity to the spiritual needs of the world and loss of the Christian's physical, mental, or spiritual well-being (I Corinthians 9:27).

A sense of the need for spiritual growth in the light of these principles has led Calvary Christian School to adopt the following standards that are conducive to the environment that will best promote the spiritual welfare of the student. The school, therefore, requests each student, whether at home, school, or elsewhere to:

1. Refrain from swearing, indecent language, smoking, drinking alcoholic beverages, the use of illegal drugs, and gambling.
2. Maintain Christian standards in courtesy, kindness, morality and honesty.

The selection of the restrictions mentioned in this pledge may appear arbitrary to some; but while not condemning others who see differently, Calvary Christian School believes that the restrictions named are outstanding types of conduct which are detrimental to the standards established as its objective.

Students are expected to abide by the standards throughout their enrollment whether at home, school, or elsewhere. Students found to be out of harmony with the Calvary Christian School ideals of work and life will be invited to withdraw whenever the general welfare demands it, even though there may be no special breach of conduct.

In this atmosphere of definite and positive Christian standards of conduct, good scholastic planning, and personal interest between faculty and student, there is fine opportunity for development of strong Christian character.

### **STATEMENT OF COOPERATION**

1. The administration has full responsibility for placing my child in the proper grade.
2. Since the fees do not cover the actual cost of educating each child, we recognize that our participation is needed in prayer, service, and gifts in order to properly share in his training.
3. The school reserves the right to dismiss any student who himself or whose parent does not respect its spiritual standards or cooperate in the educational process.
4. We understand students are accepted on a conditional basis. If acceptable progress has not been shown by the end of the first grading period, the student shall be withdrawn from Calvary Christian School and placed in a program more designed to meet his needs. The teacher's judgment shall be relied upon for the acceptability of his progress.

5. We pledge our loyalty to the aims and ideals of the School and will bring any and all questions and criticisms directly to the administration so that those in authority may properly consider them.
6. We have read the Statement of Faith and the school philosophy and are willing to have our child trained in accordance with them.
7. We have read and understand the Financial Policy of Calvary Christian School. It is our understanding that it is the school's policy to make no refunds on registration fees and that payment dates will be strictly enforced according to the school's financial statement. All monies owed to the school must be paid before records will be released.
8. We give Calvary Christian School permission for our child to take part in all school activities, including bus trips, sports activities, and school sponsored trips away from the school premises.
9. We also believe that discipline is necessary for the welfare of each student as well as for the entire school. We give permission for our child's teacher and/or other agent of the school to make and enforce classroom regulations in a manner consistent with Christian principles and discipline as set forth in the Scriptures.
10. We agree to hold the school and its agents harmless for any liability to our child or any guardian or parent thereof because of any claims on behalf of my child against the school or any agent thereof because of any injury or alleged injury to my child. Should legal action, for any reason, be taken against Calvary Christian School or any employee or agent thereof, on my child's behalf and the school or its agent not be found at fault, we agree to pay any attorney fees, court fees, damages or other costs that Calvary Christian School or its agent should incur to defend itself against such action, and would immediately withdraw our child from school as soon as such action has begun.
11. All music groups perform in various programs during the year. All elementary and secondary programs are considered part of the curriculum, and the attendance of all students in the programs is vitally important. We understand that if our child does not attend a program, his music grade will be adversely affected.
12. This Statement of Cooperation will be in effect for as long as my children listed (or others to be enrolled) attend Calvary Christian School whether it be in the daycare, pre-school, kindergarten, elementary, junior-senior high or summer school.
13. We understand that excessive tardies and/or absences may result in grade reduction and/or dismissal.
14. We have read and understand the entire contents of the Parent-Student Handbook, and we are willing to abide by all the regulations stated therein.
15. We have read and are willing to abide by the principles and standards outlined in the parent-student handbook. If we are disturbed by a policy or decision of the school, we will speak to the teacher first, then to the administrator, rather than to other parents. We understand that an uncooperative spirit on our part or the part of our child or children could lead to dismissal. If we cannot continue our support of the school, we will not try to change the school, but will quietly withdraw our child or children without seeking to discredit the ministry or its personnel.

FINANCIAL AGREEMENT**

1. Calvary Christian School does not request nor accept government funding; therefore, it is necessary that fees and tuition be paid on a timely basis. No monthly statements will be mailed.
2. All payments are due on the first of each month. After the tenth of the month, a late fee of \$20 will be charged to the account. A late reminder will be mailed showing a late charge to the account.
3. Unpaid balances cannot be carried over from one month to the next. Parents who do not pay by the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month will be notified that their children are not to attend classes on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the new month.
4. There will be a \$25.00 returned check fee on all returned checks, regardless of the reason for the return. I understand that after two returned checks, my account will be on a **cash only** basis.
5. Registration is non-refundable and non-transferable.
6. Tuition is non-refundable if the student has been to school any day during the month, or if the student drops out without proper notification. Exception will be made if the account has been paid in full for the school year.
7. Book fees and commitment fees are non-refundable after July 10<sup>th</sup>.
8. The business office will arrange any refund of fees for "full day" students. It is the parent's responsibility to notify the business office if the full day is discontinued. Parents of all children not picked up by 6:00 will pay (to the child care worker) a charge of \$1.00 per minute.
9. There will be a \$15 "emergency drop-in service" fee for parents of non-"full day" students who do not pick up their children by 12:30 or 3:30.
10. I understand that there will be a **financial hold** on my child(ren)'s report card(s) and school records if payment is not current at the end of each grading period. This financial hold will remain in effect until the account is current.
11. I understand that I am ultimately responsible for **all payments** to this account.
12. Any special financial or payment arrangements must be requested in writing and approved by the administration.
